PHOTO TIPS:

- Submit clear, crisp photos taken in the highest resolution possible. Try to avoid blurry photos, as well as low-resolution photos.
- * Remove clutter and tidy up before shooting your photos. Often less is more.
- ❖ It is best that the photos include beautiful shots showcasing the tiles. While rugs can help create a cozy atmosphere, to give yourself the best chance of winning, it is not recommended to cover up the DekTek Tiles with rugs or other coverings.
- Lighting can make a huge difference in great photos. Try to avoid taking photos when the sun is casting shadows on the deck. We recommend taking photos in both the sunlight and shade to see which turns out best. Dusk and dawn are usually peak times to take the best shots.
- Include some furnishings or staging for best results, giving your space more ambiance.
